The journey continues to the **Ngorongoro Highlands**, where you'll stay at Nomad's Entamanu Camp perched on the crater rim. The whole family will marvel at the Ngorongoro Crater, often called the "Eighth Wonder of the World," with its extraordinary concentration of wildlife, including lions, rhinos, and flamingos. Cultural visits to Maasai villages offer a chance for meaningful interaction and storytelling across generations.

Your safari then moves deeper into the legendary **Serengeti**, staying at Nomad camps in the central plains and northern reaches. Here, game drives reveal vast prides of lions, cheetahs on the hunt, and—depending on the season—the dramatic Great Migration of wildebeest and zebras. Evenings are spent around the campfire, sharing stories under star-filled skies.

Designed with families in mind, the safari balances adventure with comfort. Spacious family tents, flexible meal times, and engaging activities ensure children remain curious and happy while adults enjoy a seamless safari experience. By the end of this journey, your family will carry home not just photographs, but lifelong memories of wild Africa—crafted with Nomad Tanzania's signature warmth and authenticity.

### Day 1 : Arrival in Arusha

### Day 2 : Arusha – Tarangire National Park



After a hearty breakfast in Arusha, your guide will collect you for the drive south to **Tarangire National Park** (approximately 3-4 hours). Along the way, enjoy the changing scenery as bustling towns give way to open countryside and wildlife-rich landscapes.

On arrival, you'll settle into **Nomad's Kuro Tarangire Camp**, a beautifully secluded tented camp tucked beneath acacia and kigelia trees. The camp is designed to blend into its wild surroundings, giving your family the perfect "into the wild" experience while still offering comfort, warm hospitality, and family-friendly spaces.

In the afternoon, head out on your first **game drive** inside Tarangire. The park is renowned for its huge elephant populations, often seen in family groups digging for water along the riverbed. Children will be

amazed by the towering **baobab trees**, some over a thousand years old, and the abundance of wildlife that thrives here, including lions, leopards, buffalo, zebras, giraffes, and more than 500 species of birds.

For adventurous families with older children, Nomad also offers guided **bush walks** in the area, where expert guides teach about animal tracks, insects, and plants—perfect for curious young explorers. As the sun begins to set, enjoy your first **sundowner** together: a refreshing drink for the adults, juice for the kids, and stunning views over Tarangire’s golden plains.

Return to camp in the evening for a **andlelit dinner** under the stars. After dinner, gather around the campfire for storytelling and stargazing before retiring to your spacious tent, where the sounds of the African night—crickets, distant hyenas, and the occasional roar of a lion—lull you to sleep.

### Day 3 : Tarangire National Park - Full Day Safari
