Afterward, continue to the **Mara Triangle** for another four nights. This area is known for dramatic scenery and exceptional predator sightings. While staying at **Hemingways Ol Seki or Naboisho Camp**, you can capture big cats, sweeping plains, and river landscapes. The light and backdrop here make for stunning wildlife photography.

Your third base is the **Greater Mara**, where you spend four nights at **Entim Mara Camp**. The camp sits close to the Mara River, giving you prime access to crossing points during the Great Migration. Even outside migration season, the area teems with predators, grazing herds, and rich birdlife.

Finally, return to **Nairobi** for your last night at Hemingways before departure. This safari blends exclusive conservancy access, thrilling wildlife action, and luxury stays. It ensures you leave with not only incredible memories but also an extraordinary portfolio of images.
