


8 Days Tanzania Luxury Safari

Day 2 : Tarangire National Park – Elephants, Baobabs & Big Game



Accommodation: The Manor at Ngorongoro

Meal Plan: Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner

After breakfast at **Arusha Coffee Lodge**, your private guide will meet you for the scenic drive to **Tarangire National Park**, a journey of approximately 2.5 to 3 hours. En route, you'll pass through local villages and scenic countryside before entering one of Tanzania's most beautifully diverse parks.

Known for its giant baobab trees and dense elephant population, **Tarangire** offers incredible wildlife viewing year-round. Enjoy a **full-day game drive** in the park with a packed picnic lunch. Keep your eyes out for large herds of elephants, towering giraffes, tree-climbing pythons, buffalo, wildebeest, zebras, and predators like lions and leopards. The Tarangire River, a vital water source, attracts wildlife from miles around—especially during the dry season.

In the late afternoon, you'll exit the park and begin your drive toward the Ngorongoro Highlands. Arrive at **The Manor at Ngorongoro**, a luxurious Cape Dutch-style estate set within a coffee plantation. Warm hospitality, elegant decor, and sweeping views over the green hills await you.

Day 3 : Ngorongoro Crater Safari – The World's Largest Caldera

This natural amphitheater is home to an astonishing concentration of wildlife, including **the Big Five** — lion, elephant, buffalo, rhino, and leopard

— along with hippos, zebras, wildebeest, jackals, flamingos, and hyenas.

Enjoy a **picnic lunch** near a hippo pool, surrounded by stunning scenery and the sounds of the wild. The crater's unique ecosystem supports both predator and prey in close proximity, making for extraordinary photographic opportunities and thrilling game viewing.

In the late afternoon, ascend back to the crater rim and return to **The Manor at Ngorongoro**, where you can relax with a hot bath, tea on the terrace, or an optional horseback ride through the coffee estate.
